Community Council Notes

June 2011

Aneurin Davies chaired the meeting in June. Val Davies agreed to attend the Annual Meeting (Un Llais Cymru) on October 8th with the Clerk. The Clerk is expecting to hear from Simon Troake (County Council – Tidy Towns) concerning establishing the Picnic Area at the top of Talog road. The County Council has replied to the concerns of the Community Council and Pontweli residents about the lack of parking places for the new allotments. Since the project is to relocate the allotments, this is done on a “like for like” basis. As there was no parking provision for the original ones, it is felt there is no need for parking places for the new ones. Abbey Masonery is going to send someone out to give a price for cleaning the soldier on the War Memorial. Plans were received from the County Council outlining their intention to improve bus stops on Pencader square. Because of the absence of a shelter on Gwyddgrug road, a letter of complaint will be sent. A letter of complaint about the poor state of New Inn School yard will also be sent. It was passed that we would pay for planting the flower troughs again this year.

Local Eisteddfod

It is hoped the programme for next year’s Eisteddfod will be available by late October from local shops, Neuadd yr Ysgol and committee members. The costs of holding this important cultural event in our community continue to rise.
